Professional Development

Exploring New Horizons with the Professional Instructor Diploma Program

This year, I embarked on an incredible learning journey using CUPE PD funding to pursue the Professional Instructor Diploma Program. It's been a challenging yet rewarding experience that I highly recommend to anyone considering enhancing their skills through CUPE's professional development opportunities.

My Journey So Far

I began the program in February 2024 and am on track to complete it by Spring 2025. Currently, I'm working on my 11th course out of 12, which I started on December 2, 2024. One of the great aspects of this program is its flexibility: although the courses are designed to span 10 weeks, many can be completed in just 5-6 weeks if you're able to dedicate the time and effort.

All of my courses have been online, except for Delivery of Instruction, which I completed in person through Lauren at the CITL. This hands-on course was an incredible experience, providing an opportunity to collaborate and connect face-to-face in a meaningful way.



Building Knowledge and Skills

As someone who is not an instructor by title, I initially thought the courses might be difficult to navigate. However, with some extra effort, I've been able to adapt and thrive. The program has equipped me with valuable skills to design, develop, manage, and evaluate adult instruction. These skills have already proven beneficial in my current role, especially in supporting team members, and will be even more impactful as we onboard and train new team members in the future.

While my Master of Library and Information Science (MLIS) program offered some instructional courses, I always felt a gap in my ability to deliver structured instruction effectively. My background as a librarian, including my time at the Calgary Public Library, gave me opportunities to create modules and instruct system-wide as well as lead public programs. However, I knew there was so much more to learn about the art and science of instruction. This program has not only filled that gap but has also fueled my passion for helping others and embracing life-long learning.

Why You Should Consider Using PD Funding

I'm incredibly grateful for the opportunity to pursue this program through CUPE PD funding. It has provided me with the resources and support I needed to succeed. If you're considering the Professional Instructor Diploma Program or any other training to enhance your skills, I wholeheartedly encourage you to take the leap.

Whether or not you are in an instructional role, this program offers tools and insights that are highly transferable and valuable. If you've been thinking about how to use CUPE PD funding, know that it's an investment in yourself, your career, and the organization as a whole.
